

BUILDING HEIGHTS:

The maximum height of booth construction depends on your booth size:

6-10 sqm non-island, Inline, end of row, corner and peninsular booths with back and side walls	The maximum height of booth construction is 2.50 m. Hanging signs are not permitted.
12-18 sqm non-island booths, peninsular booths, with back and side walls	The maximum height of booth construction is 2.50 m at the back wall. With a minimum distance of at least 2 m towards the back wall, a maximum height of 3 m is permitted. Otherwise, extended heights and hanging signs are not permitted.
20 sqm and larger island booths only	The maximum height of booth construction is 4.50 m. The maximum height for hanging signs is 7 m (highest point).

SHELL SCHEME BOOTHS – DESIGN

Please be considerate of your neighbour and do not extend the partition panels of your shell scheme booth by using pop up-walls, wooden constructions etc.

SPACE ONLY BOOTHS – INDIVIDUAL BOOTH DESIGN

To create an open environment for the exhibition, please note that only 1/2 of any side of a booth bordering an aisle may be enclosed.

In the event EBD's design rules differ from the Messe Hamburg Technical Guidelines, the terms of the EBD rules shall prevail.

If you plan a customized booth design, you require a 2-step approval:

1. All individual booth designs must be reviewed by the EBD exhibit team. Please send the drawings incl. measurements to your exhibit liaison by September 16th.

2. For technical approval, please send:

- a. individual booth designs incl. measurements
- b. Risk Assessment (if you do not have an English one please use the template on our website)
- c. Acceptance of Technical Regulations
